"MOM'S CHERRY CAKE"

Ingredients	Instructions
1½ cups (375 mL) butter	1. With electric mixer, cream butter with sugar thoroughly.
2 cups (500 mL) granulated sugar	2. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each. Beat in extracts.
4 eggs	3. Combine 3½ cups (875 ml) of flour with baking powder and salt; mix thoroughly.
1 tsp (5 mL) each: vanilla extract, almond extract, lemon extract	4. Add flour mixture to creamed mixture alternately with milk.
4 cups (1 L) all-purpose flour, divided	5. Toss cherries with remaining ½ cup (125 ml) flour; fold into batter.
2 tsp (10 mL) baking powder	6. Pour into well-greased and floured 10-inch (3 L) Bundt pan.
1 tsp (5 mL) salt	7. Bake in 325° F (160° C) oven for 1¾ hours or until tester inserted in center comes out clean.
1 cup (250 mL) milk	8. Let cool a few minutes in pan, then turn out onto a wire rack to cool completely.
1½ cups (375 mL) red candied cherries, halved	
1½ cups (375 mL) green candied cherries, halved
